Sports Medicine

The Sports Medicine program cares for common athletic injuries. The three-pronged program includes a pedi/adolescent sports program, evening sports medicine clinics, and a community education and outreach program with linkages to gyms, sports leagues and the general public.

The pedi-adolescent sports program provides low cost services to children with sports medicine needs. This includes a pre-participation screening service for school age athletes who must see a physician before participating in school-sponsored sports. Other services include education and diagnostic treatment and care.

Evening sports medicine hours are available to assess injuries and to determine treatment needs.
